GUT FEELINGS GONE WRONG: INTERESTING CASE

A 11 year old boy came with intermittent pain in abdomen & chronic constipation since 2 years. USG revealed omental inflammation in left iliac fossa. Serum CRP was elevated, faecal calprotectin was within normal limits. CECT depicted below.

Interesting Case : DISCUSSION

CECT Abdomen shows:

Segmental enhancing circumferential wall thickening of the duodenum (third and fourth part) [red arrows] with circumferential thickening of the descending colon [green arrows]; significant adjacent mesenteric and omental fat stranding [blue arrows] with reactive mesenteric nodes; and mild ascites.

IMAGING DIFFERENTIALS:

- *Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IBD)*: long-segment bowel involvement with skip lesions. However, the presence of mural stratification, target sign, and engorged mesenteric vessels ("comb sign") are more specific for active disease. Chronic disease can present with fistulae, abscesses, and strictures.
- *Tuberculosis (TB)*: presents as short-segment bowel involvement, usually in the cecum and terminal ileum, with homogenous wall thickening. Skip involvement is uncommon, while the presence of necrotic lymphadenopathy favors its diagnosis.

FINAL DIAGNOSIS (On colonoscopic biopsy):

Mucinous adenocarcinoma of the colon with a skip lesion in the duodenum.

A RARE ENTITY DECODED:

- Mucinous adenocarcinoma (MAC) is a distinct histologic subtype of colorectal cancer characterized by abundant extracellular mucin, produced by tumor cells and pools within and around malignant glands. Mucin comprises >50% of the tumor volume.
- Colorectal carcinoma in children is a rare occurrence and has an annual incidence of roughly between 1-2 cases per million in those under 15 years.
- The prognosis of MAC can be poorer compared with conventional adenocarcinoma, possibly due to advanced stage at diagnosis, distinct tumor biology, and its poor response to chemotherapy.
- Diagnosis relies on histopathology demonstrating abundant extracellular mucin with malignant glandular cells.





QUIZ ANSWER:

CONGENITAL LOBAR EMPHYSEMA

Imaging findings:

Frontal chest radiograph (image 1)

Left upper lobe hyperinflation is observed with increased translucency and oligemia. Hyperinflated left upper lobe is crossing the midline. Deviation of mediastinal structures to the right. Atelectasis in right lower zone.

HRCT chest :

Axial and coronal images in lung window (image 2a-2d)

Left upper lobe reveals hypertransradiancy with hyperinflation and significant attenuation of left upper lobar vessels. Hyperinflated left upper lobe is crossing the midline across the mediastinum anteriorly. Rest of the lung parenchyma reveals compressive atelectasis with volume loss. Mediastinal structure are displaced towards right side.

DISCUSSION: Presentation is with breathlessness in first 6 months of life .30 % at birth and 50 % in 1st month. Respiratory distress with wheezing can be present.

M: F = 3 : 1

14 % cases are associated cardiac anomalies , renal anomalies , gastrointestinal or skin anomalies.

Association :

Left aberrant pulmonary artery.

Congenital heart defects : VSD, PDA and tetralogy of Fallot.

Masses like teratoma or foregut cyst

Bronchial atresia

Usually one lobe is affected LUL (45%), Right middle lobe (30 %), right upper lobe (20%), lower lobes (2- 10 %)

Differential diagnosis:

- Bronchial atresia
- CPAM
- Pulmonary arterial hyperplasia
- Pulmonary hypoplasia
- Swyer -James syndrome


