3) The admission to the Fellowship is made on merit on all India basis, by holding an entrance examination by the Institute.

4) **Qualification requirement: MD (Radiology) or its equivalent from a University/ Institute recognized by MCI and must have completed 02 years Senior Residency.**

5) **Number of seats: 2 (General: 1, Sponsored: 1)**

6) Application procedure:

- The candidate should fill his/her application form online available on the PGI website i.e. <http://pgimer.edu.in>. After filling application form the candidate should deposit the application fee through challan form (Triplicate) in any branch of SBI/through i-collect service.

- Candidates can go to any branch of State Bank of India with the fee payment challan duly filled in and pay the prescribed application fee in the “Power Jyoti” PUL current account of PGIMER. The challan form is required to be filled up in the name of Director, PGIMER , Chandigarh (Examination) in the Power Jyoti Account No. 32211613319 and candidates can also pay their fee through i-collect service in SBI i-collect Account No. 32222954695. In that case the INB reference No. will have to be mentioned instead of challan No. in the application form.
- Sponsored / Deputed Candidates A candidate applying for admission as a sponsored/deputed candidate is required to take the print out of the online application form 6 and furnish the certificates with his/her application through his/her employer/Sponsoring Authority for admission to the course (for more details log on to www.pgimer.edu.in)

7) SELECTION PROCEDURE:

- Selection of candidate for Fellowship PGI courses is a two-step process, with a Theory Examination followed by a Practical Examination.
- **THEORY EXAMINATION:** The theory examination will consist of a paper with two parts (Part 1 – General, and Part 2 – Specialty), each with 30 marks. Part 1 will consist of 30 multiple choice questions of MD level, each with four options and a single most appropriate response. Part 2 of the paper will consist of 30 multiple choice questions related to Pediatric Radiology, each with four options and single correct response.
- Total duration of the theory examination is 60 minutes. Each question correctly answered in Part I & part II will be awarded one mark, with 0.25 negative marking for wrong answers.
- **PRACTICAL EXAMINATION:**

- A merit list will be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained by the candidates in this theory examination. Eligible candidates will then be considered for a practical examination to be conducted by the concerned department. To qualify for practical examination a candidate (both general and sponsored/deputed) must obtain at least 30 marks in the Theory examination.
- The number of candidates eligible to appear in the practical examination will be FIVE times the number of seats to be filled in each subject, and in each category of candidates, provided the candidates score more than the cut off marks mentioned above.
- Candidates will be invited for the practical examination strictly in order of merit in the respective category based on the marks obtained by the candidates in theory paper.
- The practical examination conducted by the respective departments will have a weightage of 40 marks.
- Neither the candidates, nor the Departmental faculty conducting the practical examination, will be aware of the theory marks.
- The theory and practical examination marks will be added to obtain a final aggregate score (with a maximum of 100 marks).
- Candidates (both general and sponsored/deputed) who score at least 50 marks will qualify for a final interview with the Selection Committee.
- **INTERVIEW:**
- The final allocation of seats will be done after a personal interview by the Selection Committee appointed by the Institute. The number of candidates to be called for interview will be three times the total number of seats to be filled in each category, provided the candidates fulfill the cut off marks mentioned before. The selection will be finalized only after the candidates are interviewed by the Selection Committee.

Interview with the Selection Committee is mandatory, but does not carry any marks. A candidate who is absent at the time of interview will not be considered for admission/waiting list. In case any selected candidate fails to join by July 1st, the next candidate will be offered the seat as per the waiting list. The selection will be strictly in order of merit in the respective merits lists prepared after the theory and practical examinations. No TA/DA shall be paid to candidates for attending this interview.

8) EMOLUMENTS FOR THE CANDIDATES SELECTED ON GENERAL SEAT:

The Fellowship PGI courses have duration of one academic year. During this period, the Fellow is entitled to emoluments as prescribed by the Government of India. At present, this translates to basic pay of Rs. 67,700/- in the pay matrix (Level 11) as per 7th CPC plus other allowances as applicable.
