

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- 1) The abstracts must be submitted electronically by email to abstract.ispr2020@gmail.com. The subject of the mail should mention : Abstract Submission for ISPR2020 conference.
- 2) Originality: The abstract submitted must not have been published previously or accepted for publication in whole or in part by medical journals. Research work presented at a previous annual meeting of ISPR cannot be submitted.
- 3) Number for Submissions: There is no limit for submission of abstracts by an author..
- 4) Language: English language should be used in all the abstract submissions.
- 5) Abstracts are being invited for oral presentation only which can be for a scientific paper, educational exhibit paper or case report paper. E posters are not being invited.
- 6) All abstracts must be received by the secretariat by 21 September 2020. You will receive confirmation that your abstract has been received, indicating the abstract number which it has been allocated. Please refer to this abstract number in all correspondence regarding the abstract.
- 7) Notification of decision on abstract: Official notification of acceptance or rejection of an abstract will be emailed to the corresponding author latest by 30 September 2020.
- 8) Registration: The presenting author of an accepted abstract must register for the conference by 04 October 2020. The registration is free but mandatory.

ABSTRACT PREPARATION GUIDELINES

Before you begin, please prepare the following information:

- Presenting author's details:
Full first and family name.
Affiliation details: department, institution / hospital, city, state (if relevant), country, email address and mobile phone no.
- Co-authors' details:
Full first and family name(s).
Affiliation details: department, institution / hospital, city, state (if relevant), country, email address
- Type of the presentation: Scientific research, educational exhibit or case report
- Subspeciality – Kindly mention the amongst the following areas:
 1. Neuro
 2. Head and neck
 3. Chest
 4. Cardiac and vascular
 5. Gastrointestinal and abdominal
 6. Musculoskeletal
 7. Oncologic
 8. Urogenital
 9. Others

- Abstract title.
- Abstract text – limited to 250 words
- Abstracts of the scientific paper should clearly state:
 - Background and aims
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
- Abstracts of the case report should state: case, conclusions
- Educational exhibit abstracts must be structured as follows:
 - Learning objectives
 - Background
 - Imaging Findings or Procedure Details
 - Conclusion
- Graphs and Images – A maximum of 2 images can be included per abstract.
- Disclosure of financial relationships that the author(s) may have with the manufacturer/supplier of any commercial products or services related to the work, should be indicated.
- Submitted abstracts cannot be modified or corrected after the submission deadline. There is no option to save the abstract as draft and to submit it at a later stage. If you do not submit your abstract, the information will be deleted.
