

Local Attaraction Guide for ISPR 2024 Conference Delegates and Faculty

Lucknow, the capital of Uttar Pradesh, is renowned for its rich history, cultural heritage, and architectural wonders. Known as the "City of Nawabs," it offers a blend of ancient and modern attractions.

Must-Visit Attractions:

- Bara Imambara: A grand historical structure built in 1784 by Nawab Asaf-ud-Daula.
