Paper and Poster Presentation Guidelines



- We are delighted to invite Postgraduate (PG) students and Consultants to submit abstracts. Conference registration is mandatory for Presenting Author.
- Papers and Posters would be accepted from all sub-specialties of Radiology. Nevertheless; preference to Pediatric Radiology topics is recommended.
- Each Abstract is limited to 500 words comprising of Title,
 Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusions and References.
- A maximum of 3 abstracts (1 paper and 2 e-posters) per author will be accepted for submission. Number of co-authors will be limited to 4. Certificate would only be provided to Presenting Author.
- An abstract should be sent as a word document; 14 font size using Times New Roman or Arial Font with Double Spacing.
- Copyrighted material / Plagiarism / Privacy: The work should be an original unpublished work of the author(s). If any material (text, images, graphs, charts, etc.) is borrowed from other sources, the authors are responsible to obtain appropriate permissions.
- The Identity of the Patient (Name, Hospital ID) should not appear in any of the Images.




Maheshwar
